Power of Goodness offers AVP mini-workshops organized around a story and a theme. We use stories posted at FriendsPeaceTeams.org/power-of-goodness in a number of different languages. They welcome more story submissions, and any story can be used. We find stories of about 500 words work best in community settings. These AVP tasters focus on spreading the message of peace and nonviolence, rather than on the more in-depth training of AVP workshops, in groups or assemblies that can be much larger than a workshop. These workshops are typically 1-2 hours, using the AVP agenda format: welcome, gathering, agenda preview, story, story discussion, a related activity, light and lively, reflection, and closing.
